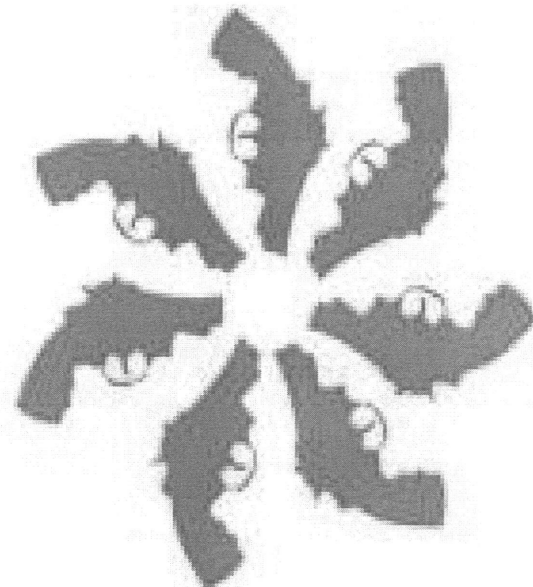

Troilus and Cressida

is a play penned in the early 17th century A.D., about a war fought in the 13th century B.C., and being performed for you today in the 21st century A.D. That's a span that covers a remarkable amount of human history, yet surprisingly little has changed. The concerns and challenges that face the characters in this play are the same as those we face today, and those which were likely faced by the ancient inhabitants of Greece and Troy on whose actions this play is based. The obligations of duty, nation, and family; the joys and sorrows of love; the trials of death and war; the often painful consequences of being labeled as the "wrong kind of person" --

all of these are as fresh today as they were 400 or even 4,000 years ago. Our production, though set in ancient Troy, has all the trappings of our own time and our own wars. With luck, this will remind us of the common joys and pains which link us as humans across time, and -- perhaps most importantly in these days of international conflict -- across cultures. It is my hope that in watching this play you find yourself drawn to the struggles of every character, across lines of nationality, religion, gender, time, and ideology.
